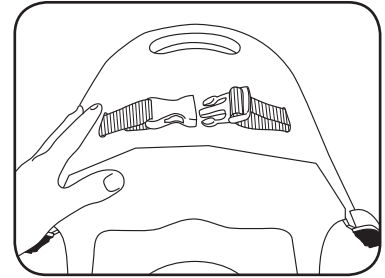


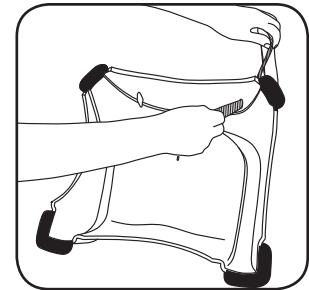
KB327 REPLACEMENT STRAP INSTRUCTIONS

P/N 440-KIT

1. Turn the booster chair upside-down, with the back of the chair towards you. The two ends of the strap should be visible on the inside of the back wall of booster. Take one end of the strap and pull it into the cavity under the chair about 2”.

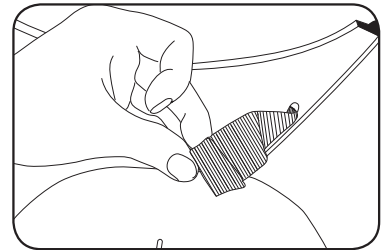


2. Pinch the tab on the end of the strap flat against the strap and push it through the slot (which the strap passes through) in the back of the seat towards the outside of the chair. This should release the strap from the chair.

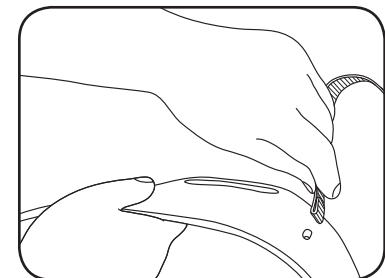


3. Repeat Step 2 for the other end of the strap.

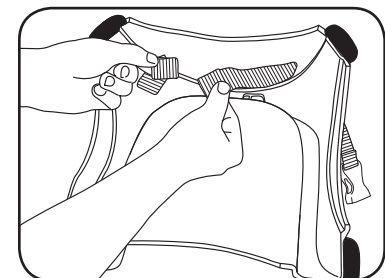
4. Take the new strap and unclip it so that your right hand is holding the side connected to the male half of the buckle. Put the other side of the strap down for now.



5. On the end of the strap opposite the buckle, there is a stitched fold. Position the fold so it is on the right side of the strap (facing the right arm of the chair). Pinch the end of the strap so it is flat and insert it through the slot on the right side of the back of the chair. Ensure that you push the fold completely through the slot.



6. Once the fold is through the slot, pull the fold away from the strap and pull any slack back through the slot towards the outside of the chair and yourself. The fold should act as retainer and hold the strap to the chair.



7. Repeat the previous 3 steps to install the female half of the strap to the left slot on the chair.

8. Once both ends of the strap are installed buckle the strap together, clean the chair and return it to use.
