



## **Production Operator I**

### **SUMMARY**

Under continuous supervision, performs standardized, repetitive tasks in assembly of baby changing tables, highchairs and related subassemblies.

**TYPICAL FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES** include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

Under direction of Production Supervisor or his/her designee, performs various aspects of assembling baby changing tables, highchairs, and seating products, including sub-assembly, final assembly, parts, bagging, making cartons and packaging.

Functions are more varied and complex than entry level sub-assembly and a wider knowledge of product line is required.

May utilize hand tools, power tools and various machines.

May be called upon to do repair or rework of sub-assemblies/assemblies.

Able to operate manufacturing equipment.

Must be responsible for and knowledgeable of quality, workmanship, and company production standards.

Required to complete labor card for each job performed.

Understands the Four Level Defect Grading System and continually seeks out, reports and contributes to problem solving in order to correct or prevent quality defects and errors.

Works in accordance with all safety standards.

Work is subject to inspection and checks.

Maintains work area in a neat and orderly manner.

Performs all other duties as assigned.
